

Description	Arginine- 13 C ₆ , 15 N ₄ , d ₇ hydrochloride is 13 C and 15 N-labeled Arginine (hydrochloride) (HY-W014375). Arginine hydrochloride is an arginine derivative.
In Vitro	Stable heavy isotopes of hydrogen, carbon, and other elements have been incorporated into drug molecules, largely as tracers for quantitation during the drug development process.
