Description

PGE-M is a metabolite of prostaglandin  $E_2$  (PEG<sub>2</sub>) as a biomarker of inflammation and cancer including advanced colorectal neoplasia, ovarian cancer, prostate cancer and so on. Urinary PGE-M is positively associated with obesity, smoking and lung metastases with breast cancer<sup>[1][2][3]</sup>.
