## **BIOLOGICAL ACTIVITY**

Description

5-(2-Azidoethyl)uridine is a purine nucleoside analog. Purine nucleoside analogs have broad antitumor activity targeting indolent lymphoid malignancies. Anticancer mechanisms in this process rely on inhibition of DNA synthesis, induction of apoptosis, etc<sup>[1]</sup>. 5-(2-Azidoethyl)uridine is a click chemistry reagent, it contains an Azide group and can undergo coppercatalyzed azide-alkyne cycloaddition reaction (CuAAc) with molecules containing Alkyne groups. Strain-promoted alkyne-azide cycloaddition (SPAAC) can also occur with molecules containing DBCO or BCN groups.
