Description	PDE4-IN-13 is a PDE4 inhibitor with an IC ₅₀ of 1.56 μ M. PDE4-IN-13 shows anti-inflammatory and antioxidant properties \square and can be used for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) research [1].
IC ₅₀ & Target	PDE4 1.56 μM (IC ₅₀)
In Vitro	PDE4-IN-13 (compound 6o) reducesTNF- α production induced by lipopolysaccharide (LPS) in RAW264.7 macrophages and malondialdehyde (MDA) production induced by Fe ²⁺ in mouse lung homogenate. Meanwhile, PDE4-IN-13 shows outstanding abilities in reducing Fe ³⁺ and complexing Fe ^{2+[1]} . MCE has not independently confirmed the accuracy of these methods. They are for reference only.
In Vivo	PDE4-IN-13 (compound 6o) (50 mg/kg and 100 mg/kg, i. p.) distinctly prevents LPS-induced serum levels of TNF- α in mice ^[1] . MCE has not independently confirmed the accuracy of these methods. They are for reference only.
