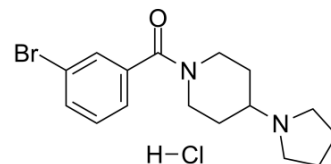

BIOLOGICAL ACTIVITY

Description	UNC926 hydrochloride is a methyl-lysine (Kme) reader domain inhibitor that inhibits L3MBTL1 with an IC ₅₀ of 3.9 μM ^[1] .
IC₅₀ & Target	IC ₅₀ : 3.9 μM (L3MBTL1), 3.2 μM (L3MBTL3), 15.6 μM (L3MBTL4) ^[1]
In Vitro	<p>UNC926 also exhibits a low micromolar affinity for the close homolog, L3MBTL3 (IC₅₀ of 3.2 μM), with a decrease in affinity for the other MBT domains and no binding to CBX7^[1].</p> <p>UNC926 (1-25 μM) inhibits binding of the 3xMBT domain to H4K20me1. UNC926 inhibits the association of L3MBTL13xMBT with the appropriate histonepeptides in a dose-dependent manner. UNC926 does not have an effect on the binding of 53BP1 to H4K20me1, demonstrating specificity of UNC926 for L3MBTL1 over 53BP1^[1].</p> <p>MCE has not independently confirmed the accuracy of these methods.
