BIOLOGICAL ACTIVITY

Description	Colistin methanesulfonate sodium salt exhibits MIC values ranged from 4 to 16 mg/liter against susceptible strains (<i>P. aeruginosa</i>) ^[1] .
In Vitro	Colistin methanesulfonate is less bactericidal than colistin at the same multiples of the MIC. Colistin and colistin methanesulfonate are both unequal mixtures of the salts of two components, colistins A and B (1), which may well have different in vitro activities ^[1] . MCE has not independently confirmed the accuracy of these methods. They are for reference only.
