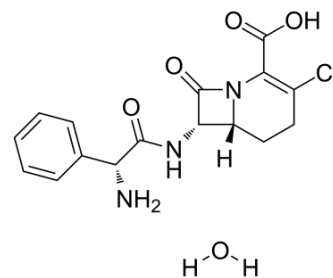

Description	Loracarbef hydrate, a cephalosporin antibiotic, is an orally active second-generation synthetic beta-lactam antibiotic of the carbacephem class ^{[1][2]} .
In Vitro	Loracarbef hydrate demonstrates excellent activity against isolates of Escherichia coli and Klebsiella, Proteus and Salmonella species ^[2] . MCE has not independently confirmed the accuracy of these methods. They are for reference only.
