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Description	(E/Z)-Squalene ((E/Z)-Super Squalene; (E/Z)-AddaVax) is a triterpenic compound. (E/Z)-Squalene accumulates and reduces liver cholesterol and triglycerides in the liver. (E/Z)-Squalen regulates the production of intracellular active oxidants (ROS) and induces apoptosis and necrosis in a concentration-and time-dependent manner ^[1] .
In Vitro	(E/Z)-Squalene (0-50 μM) reduces intracellular ROS levels in human mammary epithelial cells (MCF10A), prevents H ₂ O ₂ - induced oxidative damage, and protects cells from DNA oxidative damage ^[1] .
