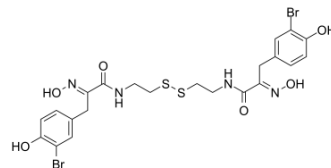

Psammaplin A possesses the antimicrobial effect on the Gram-positive bacteria and inhibits DNA synthesis and DNA gyrase activity. Antitumor Activity ^{[1][2]} .
