BIOLOGICAL ACTIVITY

Description	KALA is an amphiphilic peptide that forms an α -helical structure at physiological pH. KALA modifies a plasmid DNA-encapsulating liposomal membrane and is used as a fusogenic peptide in order to achieve effective liver targeting and transfection of DNA via galactose receptors ^[1] .
In Vitro	When a plasmid DNA-encapsulating liposomal membrane is modified with the KALA peptide, transgene expression and immune activation are facilitated in bone marrow-derived dendritic cells (BMDCs) ^[1] . MCE has not independently confirmed the accuracy of these methods. They are for reference only.
