Formulation	Supplied as a 0.22 μm filtered solution of 50 mM Tris-HCl, pH7.5, 200 mM NaCl, 20% glycerol.
Endotoxin Level	<1 EU/µg, determined by LAL method.
Reconsititution	Please use rapid thawing with running water to thaw the protein.
Storage & Stability	Stored at -80°C for 1 year. It is stable at -20°C for 3 months after opening. It is recommended to freeze aliquots at -80°C for extended storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Shipping	Shipping with dry ice.

DESCRIPTION

Background

The RING finger (RNF) protein contains the RING domain, and exerts E3 ubiquitin ligase that mediates the covalent attachment of ubiquitin to target proteins. RNF protein plays a role in cancers and viral infection. RNF113B belongs to the RNF protein family^[1].
