Formulation	Supplied as a 0.22 µm filtered solution of 50 mM Tris-HCl, pH7.5, 200 mM NaCl, 20% glycerol.
Endotoxin Level	<1 EU/µg, determined by LAL method.
Reconstitution	Please use rapid thawing with running water to thaw the protein.
Storage & Stability	Stored at -80°C for 1 year. It is stable at -20°C for 3 months after opening. It is recommended to freeze aliquots at -80°C for extended storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

### DESCRIPTION

Background	GOX2015 Protein exhibits the capability to oxidize both D-glucose and D-mannose, displaying a distinct preference for the latter with a catalytic efficiency approximately 15 times greater than that observed with glucose. This enzymatic activity is strictly reliant on the presence of NADP, emphasizing its crucial role as a cofactor for the oxidation process. The substrate specificity and dependence on NADP underscore the unique biochemical characteristics of GOX2015, shedding light on its potential functional significance in cellular metabolic pathways.
