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Appearance	Lyophilized powder.
Formulation	Lyophilized from a 0.2 $\mu$ m filtered solution of PBS, pH 7.4. Normally 5 % - 8 % trehalose, mannitol and 0.01% Tween 80 are added as protectants before lyophilization.
Endotoxin Level	<1 EU/µg, determined by LAL method.
Reconsititution	It is not recommended to reconstitute to a concentration less than 100 $\mu g/mL$ in ddH <sub>2</sub> O.
Storage & Stability	Stored at -20°C for 2 years. After reconstitution, it is stable at 4°C for 1 week or -20°C for longer (with carrier protein). It is recommended to freeze aliquots at -20°C or -80°C for extended storage.
Shipping	Room temperature in continental US; may vary elsewhere.

### **DESCRIPTION**

Background

EDNRB/Endothelin R Type B Protein, a non-specific receptor for endothelin 1, 2, and 3, operates by associating with G proteins to activate a phosphatidylinositol-calcium second messenger system. This molecular interaction mechanism underscores its pivotal role in mediating the cellular responses initiated by endothelin neuropeptides, highlighting the versatility of EDNRB in transducing signals that contribute to various physiological processes.
