Reconsititution It is not recommended to reconstitute to a concentration less than $100 \, \mu g/mL$ in ddH_2O . For long term storage it is recommended to add a carrier protein (0.1% BSA, 5% HSA, 10% FBS or 5% Trehalose).

Storage & Stability Stored at -20°C for 2 years. After reconstitution, it is stable at 4°C for 1 week or -20°C for longer (with carrier protein). It is

recommended to freeze aliquots at -20°C or -80°C for extended storage.

DESCRIPTION

Background

Fetub protein is an essential protease inhibitor involved in the process of egg fertilization. Its primary role is to prevent the premature hardening of the zona pellucida before fertilization can take place. This is likely achieved through the inhibition

of ASTL, a protease responsible for cleaving ZP2 and initiating the hardening of the zona pellucida.
