Formulation	Lyophilized from a 0.2 μm filtered solution of PBS, pH 7.4. Normally 5 % - 8 % trehalose, mannitol and 0.01% Tween 80 are added as protectants before lyophilization.
Endotoxin Level	<1 EU/µg, determined by LAL method.
Reconsititution	It is not recommended to reconstitute to a concentration less than 100 $\mu\text{g}/\text{mL}$ in ddH_2O.
Storage & Stability	Stored at -20°C for 2 years. After reconstitution, it is stable at 4°C for 1 week or -20°C for longer (with carrier protein). It is recommended to freeze aliquots at -20°C or -80°C for extended storage.
Shipping	Room temperature in continental US; may vary elsewhere.

DESCRIPTION	
Background	The GFRA3/GDNFR-alpha-3 Protein serves as a receptor for the glial cell line-derived neurotrophic factor, artemin, facilitating artemin-induced autophosphorylation and activation of the RET receptor tyrosine kinase. The protein interacts with SORL1, suggesting potential involvement in signaling cascades associated with neurotrophic responses.
