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Appearance	Lyophilized powder.
Formulation	Lyophilized from a 0.22 μm filtered solution of PBS, pH 7.4.
Endotoxin Level	<1 EU/µg, determined by LAL method.
Reconsititution	It is not recommended to reconstitute to a concentration less than 100 $\mu$ g/mL in ddH <sub>2</sub> O. For long term storage it is recommended to add a carrier protein (0.1% BSA, 5% HSA, 10% FBS or 5% Trehalose).
Storage & Stability	Stored at -20°C for 2 years. After reconstitution, it is stable at 4°C for 1 week or -20°C for longer (with carrier protein). It is recommended to freeze aliquots at -20°C or -80°C for extended storage.
Shipping	Room temperature in continental US; may vary elsewhere.

## **DESCRIPTION**

Background

PILR-alpha Protein, a member of paired receptors pivotal in immune system regulation, serves as a receptor for CD99 and PIANP. Its involvement in interactions with CD99 underscores its role in cellular recognition and immune response modulation. Paired receptors, characterized by closely related activating and inhibitory forms, play a crucial role in finely tuning the regulatory mechanisms of the immune system. The observed interactions with specific ligands emphasize PILRalpha's significance in mediating immune responses and cellular recognition processes.
