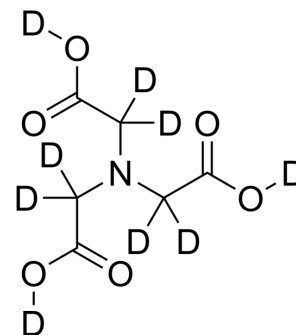

Description	Nitrilotriacetic acid-d ₉ is the deuterium labeled Nitrilotriacetic acid[1]. Nitrilotriacetic acid is an aminotricarboxylic acid. Nitrilotriacetic acid can be used as a chelating agent, forming coordination compounds with metal ions[2].
In Vitro	Stable heavy isotopes of hydrogen, carbon, and other elements have been incorporated into drug molecules, largely as tracers for quantitation during the drug development process. Deuteration has gained attention because of its potential to affect the pharmacokinetic and metabolic profiles of drugs ^[1] . MCE has not independently confirmed the accuracy of these methods.
